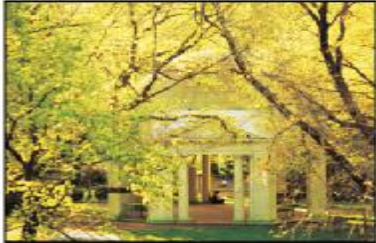




## **Australasian Dairy Science Symposium September 2007**

### **Partner Tours** **City Sights**



Discover why Melbourne is known for its old world charm, beautiful gardens and historic Victorian buildings. In the city see the Old Customs House and colourful Queen Victoria Market and in nearby Carlton the iron laced works of the terraced houses. ### **Whistles, Wine & Wildlife**



The retreat of the Dandenong Ranges has been luring visitors for over a century. Appreciate why on the train ride through the hills aboard the quaint little steam train, Puffing Billy. Across the ranges, the beautiful Yarra Valley is a delight with its rolling hills and acres of vineyards. Enjoy lunch and wine tasting at the Fergusson's Winery before the afternoon visit to the Healesville Sanctuary which is home to more than 200 species of native animals.

### ***Mornington Peninsula Wineries***

Located to the south-east of Melbourne and resting on undulating countryside between the waters of Port Phillip Bay and Westernport Bay is the Mornington Peninsula. It is the most concentrated wine region in Australia with in excess of 170 vineyards under production. The cool climate and maritime influence provide ideal conditions for the production of pinot noir, chardonnay, pinot gris and cabernet. Visits would be made to the small family owned Tanglewood Estate where an audience would be enjoyed with the winemaker, Willow Creek and Red Hill Estate wineries.

*Includes:* Deluxe transport, wine tasting with cheese & biscuits at Tanglewood Estate, wine tastings at Willow Creek & Red Hill Estate Wineries, main course restaurant lunch, glass of wine & coffee at Salix, guide, gst.

### ***Great Ocean Road***



Imagine a road that hugs the side of sheer cliffs, where the native bushland meets the blue waters of the Southern Ocean. Experience the temperate rainforest at Mait's Rest that features fern gullies and giant myrtle trees. There's also the koalas at Kennett River and the spectacular coastline that's home to the Twelve Apostles, Loch Ard Gorge and the Razorback.
